Update on Bernice Skinner:

Bernice has made phenomenal progress with God's help in the last two weeks. She no longer needs a ventilator so is breathing with a trach collar full-time and has been for a week and a half. She wears the Passey-Muir Valve (PMV) which enables her to breathe through the trach tube and speak!! She can't do long oratory yet, but assures me she has a lot to say to me about this year! The doctor caring for her here told us a few days ago the hospital has done all they can medically speaking. She now needs skilled nursing for physical therapy and speech therapy. Given the limitations involved in visiting skilled nursing and long-term care facilities in Texas, we have decided to take her home to our daughter Sharon's house here in Dallas. We will get the nursing help she needs to come there and be able to work her physical therapy more frequently. We pray this is the right decision but she clearly does better with family encouragement than medical staff encouragement.

She is going home!!!!



We are beginning the process of finding qualified men to serve this congregation as elders. We ask everyone to please be in prayer that this process will be done according to God's plan.


