

 $Iona\ Boyd$ –Is still hospitalized in the Woodlands Memorial Hermann. She has pneumonia and other complications.


Carson Longstreth - (son of Kevin Hunter's coworker) After his baseball accident, he has been released from the hospital and returned home. He is on a liquid diet.
